

## The Women Shelter in North Iceland

- The Women Shelter in North Iceland is a shelter for women and their children that can not stay at home due to violence on behalf of a partner or other members of the household. The shelter is also for women who have been raped and for women who are victims of trafficking.
- The stay in the shelter is free of charge for women and their children.
- During the stay at the shelter, women and their children are provided with food and other necessaries for daily life.
- During the stay, women are offered interviews, consult and support on the next steps, depending on the women's wishes and terms.
- The shelter also provides interviews to women who have experienced violence or currently live with a violent partner. Where they can get support, advice and/or information in relation to how to leave their abusive partner, without formally staying at the shelter.
