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Hi Pordis and Ralf,

We were actually talking about this in Pingeyri last week.

I have visited Ralf already.. and went over it with him.. seems that you have already have been

First of all: what language? English or Icelandic for the signs?

What could be added:

- -pharmacie / doctor at old people house
- -The way out of town / towards "airport" / horse houses / out of the fjord... even though the airport is not in use, it is still a good way point for people.
- -toilets? Where to get rid of garbage?

Viking area:

Before we brand this area, should we not think what the plan is?

It is good to not call it anymore "vikings village". There is the approach to call it more "viking area" or "viking pic nic area". Also have it maybe connected more with the campsite / sport area. Since there are no activities happening, it is not wise to create expectations that there is an actual village or some kind of big "attraction". However it is a really nice area, that is worth branding.

What about Isafjordbaer taking over the area?... have it slightly scaled down... a more simple, pic nic area...

I talked to Valdimar, the local hard working carpenter who build almost everything, about restoring / repairing what is needed. He told me that it would take around 6 weeks in total, with 2 good working men. He is very busy, but he could do two weeks this year, 2 weeks next year, ...

There is some woodwork to be done: fairly simple...we would remove the old cow skins and put wooden boards instead.. it lasts longer and less maintenance.

The bigger repairs are the grass / stone walls that are falling apart. These wall anyway would have to be remade again after the first 10 years of use, since the material in the wall needed to settle. When we fix the walls now, they should last much longer, since the material has settled.

What is the idea of bæjarrað about this? The viking felag has not been active for some years, nobody knows sort of what the future holds, nobody wants to take leading responsibility.

We should talk to Þórir as well about this.

(Porir is now focussed on his own viking project, Elvar and Marsibil are in Haukadalur, so there is no stakeholder behind it at the moment.)

The viking ship will likely return again.. same story...nobody knows what will happen... it turned out to be challenging to run it in Reykjavik, so unclear again...

Last years the vinnuskoli has taken care of it... Dyrafjordurdagar payed also for some maintenance when they held the festival there. The last two years the festival was held in the horse riding hall. This because of weather and because the viking area (as it is now) is a bit unsafe and unappealing.

I think soon we need to make some decisions about the viking area. I am open for any ideas or suggestions as long as things are clear and there is an actual plan.
