THE TANK bingeyri

THE TANK Pingeyri is an open-air platform including an observatory for the northern lights and workshop. Since there is an abandoned oil tank in Bakki, this existing local element is transformed to create a new value for the local future. A large part is sunk into the ground so that a tank works as a windshield for observation, and a small part is lifted up by the local rocks as a roof. This project is supposed to arose the outdoor activities through the long winter, moreover all year round.

Pingeyri will be out of the ring road after the new tunnel being opened. Since people travels from landmark to landmark, the TANK is set up to keep Pingeyri on the map with our civic pride. The TANK will be media or tool to drive contribution programs to realize attractive and lively community, moreover branding Pingeyri with value creation autonomy.
